1. Good Morning song:

2. Jolly Toddlers song:

3. Sing your ABC's

4. Ask “What month are we in?”

10. Write uppercase C and lowercase C:

Ask which one is big C and which one is little c. Then say if this is big C, is it uppercase or lowercase and vice versa. Then list words that start with C, for example “ Say C is for cat!”

11. Color song

“Red, Red touch your head (Tap head)

Blue, Blue tie your shoe (pretend to tie shoe)

Brown, Brown touch the ground (tap ground)

White, White take a bite (pretend to eat a cheeseburger)

Black, Black touch your back (touch back)

Yellow, Yellow shake like jello (wiggle)

Purple, Purple draw a circle (draw circle with finger in air)

Pink, Pink give a wink (wink)

Gray, Gray shout hurray!! (Throw hands up should hurray)

Green, Green spin like a washing machine! (spin finger and wiggle)
